

LIBRARY POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Appropriate Use of Library Policy

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all users of the UKB Library have equal access to its resources and services in a safe, respectful, and productive environment. The policy is to establish guidelines for appropriate behavior and use of resources, facilities, and services at the University of Kalba (UKB) Library.

DEFINITIONS

- **Library:** The UKB Library, which includes all resources, facilities, and services offered by the library.
- Users: Students, faculty, staff, and visitors who access the UKB Library.

POLICY STATEMENT

- Access: The UKB Library is open to all members of the university community and visitors for research, study, and educational purposes.
- **Conduct:** All users are expected to behave respectfully and responsibly, following the library's guidelines for noise levels, food and drink, and the use of library materials and equipment.
- Borrowing Privileges: Students, faculty, and staff may borrow library materials according to
 the library's circulation policies. Visitors may be granted borrowing privileges at the
 discretion of the Library Director.
- Fines and Fees: Overdue, lost, or damaged materials may result in fines or fees, as determined by the library's circulation policies.

RESPONSIBILITIES

All Library users must:

- Respect the rights and privacy of other users.
- Follow the library's rules and regulations regarding noise levels, food and drink, and use of electronic devices.
- Refrain from engaging in disruptive, inappropriate, or offensive behavior.
- Comply with copyright laws and licensing agreements when using library materials.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all users of the UKB Library, including faculty, students, staff, and visitors.
